

The Resident Sticker Parking Program Has Changed as of April 15th

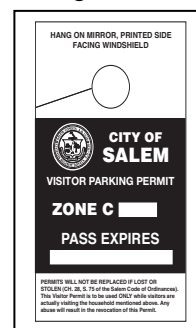


As a result of citizen concerns with regard to the existing resident sticker parking program, new regulations will be implemented beginning on April 15, 2009.

Outlined below are the program changes and the information you need to know in order to obtain your new sticker and ensure your compliance with the new regulations.

Every eligible* resident must purchase a new sticker. The cost of the new sticker is \$10, and will be valid for a two year period. Each new sticker will be color-coded by zones and will include an expiration date and a place for your vehicle registration number. Funds will be used to improve the program and provide more effective and consistent enforcement of the resident sticker parking program within neighborhoods.

Visitor passes have also been newly designed. They will be color coordinated by zone and also include an expiration date. The cost of each visitor pass will be \$1.
(limit 2 passes per unit)



You can obtain your new stickers:

→In person at the Collector's Office - The Collector's office is located on the first floor of City Hall in Room #4 and is open late on Thursday evenings (see full hours of operation at salem.com). In order to service you more expeditiously, please remember to bring with you your (1) license, (2) vehicle registration, and (3) a utility bill or a copy of your lease. The following staggered schedule for sticker registration will be implemented by zone:

April 15 thru May 14 – Zone F Residents
May 15 thru June 14 – Zone A and B Residents
June 15 thru July 15 – Zones C, D, and E Residents

→By mail – Just download the application on line at www.salem.com on the Collector's Office home page. Fill it out and mail it with the required vehicle registration information and a check made payable to the City of Salem. Your new resident sticker will be sent to you via first class mail.

→You may also use the drop box in front of City Hall – Complete the resident sticker parking application, include the required vehicle registration information and a check made out to the City of Salem. Your new resident sticker will be sent to you via first class mail.

Enforcement within your zone will begin the day after the last date noted above for your zone. For example, Zone B enforcement will commence on June 15th. Old stickers and old visitor passes will no longer be valid. You must have a new sticker on your vehicle or it will be subject to ticketing.

These program changes have been designed to make the program more effective, increase enforcement, and reduce abuse. If you have any questions regarding these new sticker parking regulations, please contact the City Collectors Office at 978-745-9595, ext. 5621.

(*Stickers will only be issued to residents that qualify for the resident parking sticker program as outlined in Section 75 of the City of Salem Traffic Ordinance)

Salem State College students: Resident Stickers are valid for one (1) year and Visitor Passes are not allowed. In addition to the three forms of ID, you **must** also provide an official stamped letter from the Registrar's Office.

Visitor Pass - \$1.00 each (Limit two passes per unit)
