Background: On September 27, 2007, the City Council adopted City Ordinance Article VI. Theatrical Exhibitions, Public Amusements. The Ordinance gives the Licensing Board the power to grant entertainment licenses for theatrical exhibitions, including cabaret type exhibitions. The Ordinance established general requirements for review and permitting, but required the Licensing Board to adopt a set of rules and standards for the applications for adult entertainment licenses. A draft set of rules and standards for the Board will be discussed at the public hearing. A copy of the draft Rules, Regulations, Standards and Procedures for Granting, Conditioning, Denying, Suspending or Revoking Entertainment Licenses for Adult Activities may be obtained by visiting the Licensing Board office on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of 120 Washington Street, Salem, MA or by downloading it from the Licensing Board's web page at Salem.com.

Rules, Regulations and Standards Approval Procedure: The Licensing Board shall hold a public hearing on January 12, 2009 at 6pm at which time it will accept public comment. The Board shall also accept written comment through January 26, 2009.
