

--The bidder has disclosed to the Salem Public Schools the ownership and management staff proposed for the Salem Public School contract. The Salem Public Schools reserves the right to approve or disapprove of such management and staff and the contractor will make a good faith effort to respect the wishes of the district. The successful bidder will assign a person, who will be available to the Superintendent of Schools, or authorized representative, for the purpose of conferences and consultations related to bus schedules, bus routes, bus stops, student behavior, billing, and other related matters. --All drivers and monitors will be certified in administering CPR/First Aid and EpiPen therapy prior to the commencement of the contract. The successful bidder will be required to present each driver's and monitor's certification prior to commencement of work under this procurement,	<u>no</u>
--All vehicles will be equipped with two-way radios under the direction of the FCC prior to the start of the contract. This will be the responsibility of the Vendor. The Vendor will stay on a frequency that will be monitored by Salem Public Schools on a monitoring device provided by the vendor. 
