## WEEKLY RECYCLING PICKUP

- Same day as your trash. Now you can recycle **every week!**
- There is **no limit** to the amount of recycling you can put out.

*Additional recycling bins are available at Crosby's Marketplace, Winer Bros. Hardware, or at the DPS building. Recycling labels are available at 120 Washington Street for your own containers.*

## ALL CARDBOARD MUST BE RECYCLED

- State regulations ban the disposal of cardboard as trash (*including all types of cardboard, thin as well as corrugated*).
- All boxes must be **flattened** and **bundled no larger than 3'x3'**.

*Cardboard not properly prepared **will not be picked up!** Cardboard also can be brought to the **Transfer Station** or **North Shore Recycled Fibers**.*

## THREE TRASH BARRELS PER HOUSEHOLD

- Each individual household may put out no more than **three bags or barrels of trash per week**.
- Each barrel or bag must be **no larger than 35 gallons and weigh no more than 50 lbs.**
- Households are limited to one bulk item per week.

**No construction debris!** See website about "Construction & Demolition Debris."
