Paving Program General Project Information

- 1. Description of Work:
 - a. Work on your street will consist of grinding out the top 2-inches of existing pavement and the installation of 2-inches of top coarse pavement.
 - b. Grinding will be the first activity you see, followed in a few weeks by the installation of a thin levelling course of pavement to ensure a smooth roadway surface and then adjustment of all manhole and gate box structures in the road, finally an overlay level of pavement will be installed and the final lane striping.
- 2. No work is planned during the week before and the day of Halloween.
- 3. Paving requires the use of nearby hydrants for water, the use of hydrants may cause brown water in your home for a period of time. If you notice brown water, please run a cold water faucet in the lowest part of your home, until the water runs clear.
- 4. Before the final paving is completed, your roadway will be an active construction site and you should be careful and drive at a reduced speed accordingly.
- 5. Work shall take place Monday through Friday, between the hours of 7:00 am to 3:30 pm.
- 6. On the days when the paving contractor is working on your street, it is important not to have any cars parked in the roadway.
- 7. No parking signs will be posted in advance of construction and no-parking will remain in effect until construction is complete for that day.
- 8. You will always have access to and from your driveway and parking will be allowed on the street after work hours.
- 9. Police details will always be present to assist residents through the work zone and to facilitate traffic management.
