FIRST PASSAGE

In the year two thousand and Seventeen

An Ordinance to amend an Ordinance relative to Traffic

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Salem, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 42, Section 88 – “Special Speed Regulations”

Repeal Swampscott Road – eastbound, beginning at a point two hundred (200) feet east of the junction of Highland Avenue, Route 107, thence easterly 0.30 miles at thirty-five (35) miles per hour, 0.80 miles at forty (40) miles per hour, 0.10 miles at thirty (30) miles per hour, ending at the Salem/Swampscott line; the total distance being 1.20 miles. (7/24/75 DPW 1042)

Section 2. Repeal Swampscott Road – westbound, beginning at a Swampscott/Salem Line, thence westerly 0.10 miles at thirty (30) miles per hour, 0.80 miles at forty (40) miles per hour, 0.30 miles at thirty-five (35) miles per hour, 0.04 miles at twenty-five (25) miles per hour, ending at the junction of Route 107, Highland Avenue; the total distance being 1.24 miles. (7/24/75 DPW 1041)

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by City Charter.
