LICENSING BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Present on call were: Chairman Gary Barrett, member Deb Greel, Clerk of the Board, Melissa Pagliaro, City Solicitor Elizabeth Rennard and Special Investigator to the Board, Sgt. John Doyle.

- 1. Application for a One Day Liquor License for the Salem Farmers Market from June 2020 through October 2020. Applicant: 634 Meadery, Dan Clapp.
 - Ms. Pagliaro presented the application and Sgt. Doyle said he has worked the Market for a few years and there has never been an issue. Ms. Greel motioned to approve. Mr. Barrett seconded.
- 2. Application for a Common Victuallers License at 11 Dodge Street. Applicant: Dodge Area, LLC d/b/a Salem Hampton Inn.
 - Josh Morin presented the application. He said this is for the breakfast and snack area at the new hotel. Ms. Pagliaro said that the paperwork was complete. Ms. Greel motioned to approve. Mr. Barrett seconded.
- 3. Approval of Meeting Minutes from meeting on March 23, 2020. Ms. Greel motioned to approve. Mr. Barrett seconded.
- 4. Old/New Business:
 - Sgt. Doyle said he would like to bring a complaint for a Hearing to the Board regarding noise at Bit Bar, St. Peter St.
 - Ms. Pagliaro said the applicant for the Class II Auto Dealer's Application should be ready to go for the June the meeting.
