Project Objectives

- 1. Improve complete streets elements to Derby Street
 - improve pavement, pavement markings and signage
 - Updated and accessible sidewalks
 - Enhanced roadway crossings
 - Bicycle network system
- 2. Improve Sidewalks on finger streets off Derby Street
 - Reconstruction
 - Widen (where possible)
 - Drainage improvements
 - Cross slopes
- 3. Improve Shared Use Path Connections
 - Peter Tracy Multiuse path extension
 - Szetela Lane to Derby Street
 - Area wide pavement marking upgrades

Derby Street upgrades


Construct new pavement and markings

- New Derby Street to Orange Street
- Orange Street to Fort Avenue


Sidewalk Improvements

- Update pedestrian ramps
- Install tactile warning panels
- Refresh cross walk locations
- Repairs
 - Widen to 4 ft minimum using bump outs and removing select trees/ obstacles
 - Reduce severe cross slopes to work towards ADA compliance





Finger Street Sidewalks Reconstruction

Widen for ADA compliance when appropriate

- Side Streets one side only
- Remove ADA obstacles
- Trees
- Structures

Replace deteriorated sections

- New concrete sidewalk
- Adjust curbs as necessary


Address illegal curb cuts for driveways

- Derby Street
 - from Washington Street to Orange Street
- Fort Avenue
 - from Webb Street to Restaurant Row

- New path from Szetela Lane to Derby Street through Beattie Park
- Path upgrades along Collins Cove
- Enhanced roadway crossings at
 - Webb Street (future work based on Footprint open space design)
 - Fort Avenue
 - Szetela Lane
