 - Public recycling: Summary of 6/29 meeting minutes. Audit came back much more positive than expected. New signage and communication needed? Needs to be positive, clear but not preachy. Final, approved wording for the City's values' statement: "Enjoy our History; Don't Trash our Future - SalemRecycles Greensalem.com"
 - Plastic bag update: Presentation made to City Council. Update to be provided at September meeting.

 - Two markets have been attended to date to raise awareness of our events and work. Well received.
