




## Welcome to Fall in Massachusetts!

Next we'll enjoy lunch at the charming **Vienna Inn**. Here your wait staff will be dressed in authentic attire, and you will have a chance to travel to Austria without leaving Massachusetts! We will begin with a salad followed by your choice of Wiener Schnitzel (Veal) with Braised red cabbage, Spatzle, Lingonberry & Lemon; Chicken stuffed with Asiago Cheese, Spinach & Herbs topped with a Tarragon Cream; Sliced Tenderloin of Beef served with an Au Poivre Sauce; Hofbrauhaus Wurstplatte of Bratwurst & Knockwurst with braised Sauerkraut, Spatzle & Mustard; or Salmon with Hollandaise Sauce. All will be served with proper accompaniments, coffee, tea and a German inspired dessert.

After lunch we will head to a local **orchard** where everyone will receive a bag of apples to take home, and you can browse the gift shop for other seasonal specialties.
