

Paving Program

General Project Information

1. Description of Work:
 - a. Work on your street will consist of grinding out the top 2-inches of existing pavement and the installation of 2-inches of top coarse pavement.
 - b. Grinding will be the first activity you see, followed in a few weeks by the installation of a thin levelling course of pavement to ensure a smooth roadway surface and then adjustment of all manhole and gate box structures in the road, finally an overlay level of pavement will be installed and the final lane striping.
2. No work is planned during the week before and the day of Halloween.
3. Paving requires the use of nearby hydrants for water, the use of hydrants may cause brown water in your home for a period of time. If you notice brown water, please run a cold water faucet in the lowest part of your home, until the water runs clear.
4. Before the final paving is completed, your roadway will be an active construction site and you should be careful and drive at a reduced speed accordingly.
5. Work shall take place Monday through Friday, between the hours of 7:00 am to 3:30 pm.
6. On the days when the paving contractor is working on your street, it is important not to have any cars parked in the roadway.
7. No parking signs will be posted in advance of construction and no-parking will remain in effect until construction is complete for that day.
8. You will always have access to and from your driveway and parking will be allowed on the street after work hours.
9. Police details will always be present to assist residents through the work zone and to facilitate traffic management.
