EMERGENCY ORDER REGARDING PERSONAL CARE SERVICES

On FRIDAY, MARCH 20, 2020 the City of Salem Board of Health declared a Public Health Emergency in the City of Salem.

Effective **SUNDAY, MARCH 22, 2020 AT 12:01AM** all services offered to the public which cannot be provided at a distance of at least six (6) feet, in accordance with CDC social distancing guidelines, are hereby Ordered to cease operations and close. This includes, but is not limited to:

- All beauty salons
- All hairdressers and barber shops
- All nail salons/spas
- All tattoo establishments including those that microblade
- All fitness centers/gyms
- All massage/foot spa establishments.
- All churches and religious congregations and services
- All psychic studios and parlors

This emergency order shall remain in effect until notice is given, pursuant to the Board of Health's judgement, that the Public Health Emergency no longer exists.
