The Brookhouse Home submitted a request for \$3,760.47 from the Endicott Fund. This FY20 Large Grant for \$5,000.00 was approved in August 2019. No vote required.

Richard Lobsitz made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 12, 2019 meeting. The motion was seconded by Thaddeus Buczko and voted unanimously.

A thank you letter from Samaritan Charitable Society of Salem was received for the FY20 Large Grant.

A thank you letter from Catholic Charities-North was received for the FY20 Large Grant.

LEAP for Education sent a letter and brochure of their 2019 Annual Report. The Board reviewed the information.

William P. Goreham distributed the First Quarter Report – ending September 30, 2019. The total Market Value listed was \$8,984,149.52. The Board discussed and reviewed the information presented from the Eastern Bank.
