NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 87, Section 3 (Public Shade Trees), a public hearing will be held by the City of Salem Tree Warden regarding the proposed removal, trimming and/or cutting of certain public shade trees by New England Power Company d/b/a National Grid (the "Company") in conjunction with the construction and installation of two 115 kV underground transmission lines known as the Salem Cables Project (the "Project").

The trees in front of the following properties may have roots disturbed and/or be cut, trimmed and/or removed or not be affected at all by the Project: 57 Canal Street (1 Maple); 219 Washington Street (1 Shrub); 76 Lafayette Street (5 Oak); 136 Derby Street (1 Dogwood); 24 Fort Avenue (2 Honey Locust); 29 New Derby Street (2 Oak); 32 New Derby Street (1 Oak).

The affected trees range in trunk size from approximately 2.1 inches diameter breast height (dbh) to 20 inches dbh, and generally range in height from approximately 4 feet to 45 feet.

The Project has been reviewed by the Energy Facilities Siting Board and the City of Salem. In the event that a public shade tree must be removed, the Company has agreed to plant replacement trees in accordance with Salem's tree replacement policies. The replacement trees will be planted in the vicinity of each removed tree in locations to be determined by the Tree Warden.

The Public Hearing will be held on **February 29, 2016** at **6:00 P.M.** at 120 Washington Street, 3rd Floor, Conference Room in Salem, Massachusetts. Any person interested or wishing to be heard on this matter should appear at the time and place designated.
