## Annual New Dog License / Annual Renewal Dog License

Per the City of Salem Ordinances, Sec. 8-31 all dogs 6 months or older, or who have obtained its first rabies vaccination, must be licensed by the first of April each year. Proof of current rabies is required.

The fee is as follows:

Intact Male / Female - \$15.00 Neutered / Spayed - \$10.00 (Proof required)

Payment can be made by mail to the address listed above. Please enclose a check or money order (payable to the City of Salem), along with proof of rabies and neuter/spay.

Or you can pay in person at City Hall, Room 3, City Clerk's Office by cash, check, credit or debit card. There is a bank surcharge for credit and debit payments.

Any dog <u>license renewal</u> received <u>after July 1st</u> is subject to a \$15.00 late fee, plus any prior license fees not paid.
