Only permanent Civil Service Police Officers from Massachusetts are eligible for transfer under the provisions of Chapter 31, Section 35 of Massachusetts General Laws. Applicants must have successfully graduated from a Massachusetts Municipal Training Council (MPTC) Basic Police Officer Full-Time Police Officer Academy, in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 41, section 96B. Applicants must possess solid problem solving skills and have strong verbal and written communication skills.

Applicants will be subject to an extensive background investigation, medical evaluation, psychological screening, and oral board interview.
