

CITY OF SALEM

FIRST PASSAGE

In City Council, September 10, 2015

Ordered:

That the sum of Two Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$2,250,000.00) be and hereby is appropriated to pay the costs associated with the remediation of the Salem Transfer Station property located at 12 Swampscott Road, Salem, MA 01970, including demolition of the existing buildings and structures, capping of the onsite ash landfill, remediation of waste along wetlands, securing slope, and all other necessary work to bring the site into compliance with state and local requirements and for the payment of all costs incidental and related thereto, and that to meet said appropriation the Treasurer, with the approval of the Mayor, is authorized to borrow said sum under M.G.L. Chapter 44, Sections 7(3A) and 7(9), or pursuant to any other enabling authority, and to issue bonds or notes of the City therefor.

Be it further Ordered:

That the Mayor and the Treasurer are each authorized to file an application to qualify under Chapter 44A of the Massachusetts General Laws any and all bonds of the City issued under and pursuant hereto, and to provide such information and execute such documents as may be required in connection therewith.
