Will hold a public hearing for all persons interested in the application of Peabody Essex Museum for the property located at 161 Essex Street (Map 35, Lot 303) for a Site Plan Review in accordance with the Salem Zoning Ordinance Section 9.5 Site Plan Review. Specifically, the applicant proposes the partial demolition of existing buildings and the construction of a 37,950 square foot addition primarily within the footprint of the Asian Garden, in addition to site improvements including a garden and utility work.
