1. Application for an Entertainment License. Applicant: Salem Waterfront Hotel & Suites, Regatta Bar Restaurant, 225 Derby Street to add outdoor speakers and TV.

Tom Egan and Michael Rockett attended on behalf of the Waterfront Hotel. The Board heard the Hotel's petition for an amendment of the Entertainment License to include 2 TVs outside, piped music on 4 speakers on the patio until 10:00 p.m. and not to exceed 70 Db. Existing license has up to a 5-piece band and DJ in the Ballroom and Compass room for events.

Mr. Flores motioned to approve the license for 60 days or until such time as the new entertainment regulations are adopted by the Board, which ever date is later.
