### MEETING MINUTES

A meeting of the Salem Licensing Board was held on Monday, June 18, 2018 at 6:00 p.m., at City Hall Annex, 98 Washington Street in the first-floor meeting room. Present was: Chairman Bob St. Pierre and member Paul Flores, Clerk of the Board, Melissa Pagliaro and Special Investigator, Sgt. Doyle.

1. Application for Street Performers Licenses. Applicants: Mark Matejih, Jr., Douglas Henry Wildes, Tiffany Kearin, Anthony Spaziani, Rebecca Beaulieu Craig Simonetti and Benjamin Hellman.

Present were Anthony Spaziani, Craig Simonetti and Benjamin Hellman. They all agreed they read the rules and regulations and understood them. Sgt. Doyle reminded them of the decibel levels and areas that allow certain things. Mr. St. Pierre said he would accept a motion to approve. Mr. Flores said so moved.

2. Board's approval of required Legal ad for previously approved application for an Alteration of Premise. Applicant: Notch Brewing Company, 283R Derby St.

Ms. Pagliaro explained that this is just a formality so the paperwork can be sent to ABCC again for final approval. Mr. St. Pierre said he would accept a motion to approve. Mr. Flores said so moved.

Deb Costa presented the application and said all of the paperwork is in order for this booked event. Mr. St. Pierre said he would accept a motion to approve. Mr. Flores said so moved.

7. Application for a one-day liquor license on October 20, 2018 at Ames Hall, Salem YMCA, Sewall St. from 5pm-12am for a Wedding for 175 people. Applicant: Adir Ferreira, Jr.

Adir Ferreira presented the application. He said that all of the paperwork is in order to hold his Wedding Reception at Ames Hall. Mr. St. Pierre said he would accept a motion to approve. Mr. Flores said so moved.

8. Application for a one-day liquor license on June 20, 2018 at The Bridge @ 211 from 6:30-10pm for 30 people for and Arts & Libations night. Applicant: Bridge @ 211.

Chris Weiss presented the application for the one night for an Arts & Libation event. Ms. Pagliaro said all the paperwork is in order. Mr. St. Pierre said he would accept a motion to approve. Mr. Flores said so moved.

9. Application for a Blanket License for the PEM for Outdoor Entertainment on July 21<sup>st</sup> from 6-10pm for a Museum Block Party on Essex Street.

Donecca Thurston, PEM & George McCabe presented the application. She said they will have their own security and police details as well. She said all hands will be on deck. She said there will be two food vendors and a food truck from 3-10pm and Entertainment from 3-10pm and two beer gardens from 6-10pm. Mr. St. Pierre said he would accept a motion to approve. Mr. Flores said so moved.

10. Application for a Change of License Category from and Annual Wine and Malt License to and Annual All Alcohol License through Home Rule Petition. Applicant: Pamplemousse, Essex St.

11. Application for a Common Victualler License. Applicant: Salem MT Donuts, LLC d/b/a Honey Dew Donuts, 138 Canal St.

George Tecci, new owner, presented the application. Mr. St. Pierre asked what the was going to do. Mt. Tecci said that this application is for the Honey Dew on Canal Street and that nothing is changing. He said he would like to open at 5am. Ms. Pagliaro instructed him to see the City Clerk's Office and that the LB can approve the hours from 6am-11pm. She said he needs to go through the Council for an early open or extended closing hours.

12. Application for a Transfer of an Annual All Alcohol License, currently Salem Hospitality Group, Inc., 161 Essex St. to Peabody Essex Museum, Inc. at the same location.  
Attorney Joe Devlin presented the application and also present was Bob Monk and Owen Higgins. Ms. Pagliaro said they have been working together and all of the required paperwork is ready to be filed with the State. Mr. St. Pierre said he would accept a motion to approve. Mr. Flores said so moved.
13. Application for a Transfer of an Annual All Alcohol License, currently Thomand, Inc. at 300 Derby Street to Casa Tequila Salem MA LLC d/b/a Casa Tequila and a Pledge of a Liquor License to Bank of America and US Small Business Administration, at the same location.  
The attorney for this transfer asked for an extension until the next meeting on July 16, 2018.
14. Application to amend Entertainment License to include live entertainment in the form of Variety Shows, Burlesque, Trivia and Karaoke. Applicant: Deacon Giles Distillery, 75 Canal St.

15. Application for Entertainment in July & August at Derby Sq. and in August for the Festival, Vendors and two one-day Liquor Licenses at Salem Willows, August 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup>. Applicant: Salem Jazz and Soul Festival.  
Ian Cannon, Board President, presented the application. He said this is the 12<sup>th</sup> year and it is a great event. He said there has never been a problem. He said they raised over 8,000 last year for Salem. He said they would like to have the same as last year with a beer and hard cider tent. He said Ipswich Ale will be hosting. He said there will be details in and around the tent. He said everything else is in order. Mr. St. Pierre said he would accept a motion to approve. Mr. Flores said so moved.
