LICENSING BOARD MEETING MINUTES - DRAFT

- 1. Application for a One Day Liquor License for a Beer Garden and Entertainment License on October 31st, Halloween Night from 2-10pm at Federal and Washington St. Applicant: The Anthem Group.
 - Shelby Elwell presented the application along with Ellen Talkowsky, Special Events Coordinator for the City. She said there would be double barricades and local beer and wine distributors and all of the servers are TIPS certified. Ms. Talkowsky said they were the recipient of the RFP that went out for the Beer Garden for Halloween. She said they do a great job and decorate the Garden with Halloween props. Ms. Greel motioned to approve. Mr. Barrett seconded. Roll call vote 2-0.
- 2. Application for a sub licensee Fortune Telling license at Stardust, 29 Congress St. Applicant: Angela Hunt. Angela Hunt presented the application and said she is looking to do tarot readings at Stardust on Congress St. Ms. Mojica said that all of the paperwork is in order. Ms. Greel motioned to approve. Mr. Barrett seconded. Roll call vote 2-0.
