Mr. Dominic Sebastian Panico, resident at 10 Buffum Street, Apartment 3, Salem, has submitted an application for appointment as a Constable with the City of Salem.

In support of his application, he has provided the required references attesting to his fitness to serve as a Constable in the City of Salem. Ladies and Gentlemen of the City Council:

Pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 41, section 106, I am pleased to appoint Robert LeBlanc to the position of Tree Warden. Mr. LeBlanc will be taking on the position currently held by Richard Rennard, who has very ably served our City both in this capacity and at Public Services for many years. I hope you will join me in thanking Mr. Rennard for his years of service and dedication to our City and to the people of Salem.

Mr. LeBlanc served for eighteen years as the Superintendent of Highways, Parks, and Cemeteries for the Town of Walpole, where he also held the position of Tree Warden. In that capacity he earned the Town a Tree City U.S.A. designation and competitive grants for tree planting. In Walpole, Mr. LeBlanc managed 24 acres of athletics fields and oversaw the operation and maintenance of six Town cemeteries. Having been a Tree Warden, Mr. LeBlanc comes to the position year in Salem with many years of experience and familiarity with M.G.L. Chapter 87 and relevant statutes, regulations, state programs, and best industry practices for tree management and protection.

Mr. LeBelanc has also served for 24 years in the 101<sup>st</sup> Engineer Battalion of the Massachusetts National Guard, retiring in 2010 after serving two deployments for Operation Iraqi Freedom, for which he earned the Bronze Star for leadership in a combat zone and the Meritorious Service Medal.

Mr. LeBlanc is a Massachusetts Certified Arborist, a member of the Massachusetts Arborist Association and the Massachusetts Cemetery Association, and serves on the Executive Board of the Massachusetts Tree Wardens and Foresters Association. He holds a Bachelor's degree in

urban planning from Salem State, completed Massachusetts Arborist Association's Tree School program, and is U.S. Forest Service strike team certified.

I believe Mr. LeBlanc is extremely qualified to serve as Salem's Tree Warden and, especially, to help us successfully implement the City's new tree Ordinance. I recommend confirmation of his appointment to this position and invite you to join me in welcoming him to the team in our Department of Public Services.
