TENANT CHECKLIST

Income Documentation* copies of the following that apply to <u>any</u> household member:		
	Employed:	Twelve (12) weeks of pay stubs for \underline{all} working household members.
	<u>Self-employed</u> :	Most recent $\underline{federal}$ tax return, including $\underline{Schedule\ C}$ and all attachments.
	<u>Unemployed</u> :	Three most recent checks and official letter stating start date and amount of assistance.
	Social Security:	Social Security letter from current year stating monthly benefit amount (including any child benefits).
	Public Assistance:	Recent checks as well as letter from the agency stating amount of assistance.
	Pension/Disability:	Company letter from current year stating amount of monthly benefits.
	Child Support/ Alimony:	Court Order or letter from father or ex-spouse stating amount of monthly or weekly payments.
	<u>Full Time Adult</u> <u>Students</u> :	Letter from school stating current enrollment status for household members age 18 and over.
	 □ Most recent <u>federal</u> tax return (Form 1040 with all schedules and attachments) □ Three (3) most recent months of statements for <u>all</u> savings & checking accounts for <u>each</u> household member □ Most recent quarterly statements for retirement accounts, CDs, trusts, or other investments
