Roll Call

Vote on Funding for King Lear performances by The Bard Brigade

- PAC confirmed budget
- King Lear has been split to two locations, 289 Derby and Derby Square
- No rain location has been put in place. Andrews and Naik Dwyer will look into Old Town Hall as a backup and will also confirm that there will be no live music from the Lobster Shanty during performance.
- Marketing has been widely spread through social media and local newspaper.
- A-frame sign will be used to brand the show as a Salem Public Art performance.
- Carly Naik Dwyer is a producer of the show but is not receiving any compensation.

Andrews made a motion to approve. Gachignard seconded the motion. Motion passes: 4 in favor, 0 opposed.

- Tom Daniel (Planning Department Director) confirmed that tenant will need to make handmade products
- There are multiple options including jewelry maker, soap maker, fluid art, and a woodworker
- Artists' Row Subcommittee includes John Andrews, Kylie Sullivan, Kurt Ankeny-Beauchamp, Emily Larsen

Vote to empower the Artists' Row Subcommittee to select Artists' Row tenant to fill vacancy. Gachignard made a motion to approve. Andrews seconded the motion.

Motion passes: 4 in favor, 0 opposed.
