PLACEMENT AND CARE OF CARTS

- · Place carts with wheels facing the house, so the lid opening faces the street.
- · Carts should be 3 feet apart.
- Carts must be clear of cars to allow access by Waste Management Trucks.
- · Carts are city property and assigned to specific addresses.



• Residents should label carts with address only, keep them clean, and lids closed.

SCHEDULE

Carts must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day.

Trash (64-gallon cart) - weekly collection

- Trash must be bagged. This will keep the cart clean and prevent litter on windy days.
- · Do not place recyclables in trash carts.
- · Any materials that cannot fit in the cart must be placed in approved orange overflow bags.
- · To purchase, go to: Crosby's, Ace Hardware, DPS, or the Collector's Office.
- Place orange bags on top of or beside cart loose trash will not be picked up.
- White goods are picked up monthly, and bulk items are picked up every other week on your recycling day. Please call in advance to arrange pickup of white good and bulk items at (800) 972-4545.

Non-acceptable items for trash cart

- · Dirt, sod, yard waste, concrete and rock.
- Construction/demolition debris/wood.
- Household hazardous waste and electronics.
- · Hot ashes or flammable materials such as oil, gas, and paint.

Recycling (96-gallon cart) - every other week collection on same day as trash

- All recycling goes directly into blue bin.
- · Do not place any recyclables in plastic bags.
- No sorting necessary. See center panel for acceptable items.
- Containers must be rinsed and free of food and liquids.
- See the Recycling Collection Schedule on the far right panel.
- The pickup weeks are based on the color of your recycling cart lid.

Non-acceptable items for recycling cart

 Trash, plastic bags, plastic wrap, or anything made of foam – even if a recycling symbol is present.









Great things happen when Salem residents use **Recycle Often. Recycle Right**[™]. When everyday items like those shown below are recycled, tons of raw materials, time, energy and money are saved. Plus the recycled materials become new products, and the cycle continues.

• Use your 96-gallon blue cart with either the blue or green lid.

 Recycling will be collected every-other-week depending on the color of your recycling cart lid. See the Collection Schedule on the adjacent panel to determine which weeks your recycling will be collected.

No sorting is needed.

· DO NOT BAG YOUR RECYCLABLES OR PLACE PLASTIC BAGS IN YOUR RECYCLING CART. EMPTY YOUR RECYCLABLES DIRECTLY INTO YOUR RECYCLING CART.

2018 RECYCLING AND TRASH MUNICIPAL COLLECTION SERVICE

Waste Management collects trash every week and recycling once every other week between 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on your designated service day. If your recycling cart has a green lid, your recycling will be collected on the Green weeks. If your recycling cart has a blue lid, your recycling will be collected on the Blue weeks. Recycling is mandatory in Salem.

HOLIDAYS

Collection will be delayed one day if a holiday falls on or after your regular service day. Sign up for notifications on Code Red, which you will find on the main page of Salem.com.

OTHER ITEMS

Please call Waste Management at

(800) 972-4545 for the following service items:

- · Schedule collection of an item that does not fit in your cart.
- If your cart needs repair.
- · If your trash or recycling was not picked up on your scheduled collection day.

EXCESS TRASH

Salem residents may purchase Orange overflow bags at \$12.50 per roll of 5 at: Crosby's, Ace Hardware, DPS, and the Collector's Office. These bags may be placed on top of or beside your cart.
