Broad Street Cemetery was established in 1655 and is Salem's second oldest cemetery. This beautiful historic site includes the city's largest collection of burial tombs as well as slate and marble burial markers with some of the most outstanding gravestone carvings on the North Shore. The cemetery also provides an important green space for the neighborhood with open vistas and mature trees and landscape plantings.

To preserve this community landmark, the City has embarked on a preservation master plan to identify concerns at the cemetery and to develop recommendations for future preservation work.
